

ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION SALEM BAND BOOSTERS
BYLAWS
SALEM BAND BOOSTERS, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME

THE NAME OF THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE SALEM BAND BOOSTERS, INC.

ARTICLE II - OBJECT

THE PURPOSE OF THE CORPORATION SHALL BE TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL AND MORAL SUPPORT TO THE BAND MEMBERS AND BAND DIRECTORS OF OUR SALEM MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOLS, ALSO ALL OTHER LAWFULL BUSINESS WHICH IS CONFERRED UPON THE CORPORATION BY THE VIRGINIA NONSTOCK CORPORATION ACT.

ARTICLE III — MEMBERSHIP

THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE CORPORATION SHALL CONSIST OF ANY PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF ANY SALEM HIGH SCHOOL OR ANDREW LEWIS SCHOOL STUDENT. ANY OTHER INTERESTED PERSON DESIRING TO SUPPORT OUR CAUSES MAY JOIN BY INVITATION.

ARTICLE IV — ELECTIONS

SECTION 1. THE ELECTION OF OFFICERS SHALL BE HELD IN NOVEMBER.

SECTION 2. ELECTION SHALL BE BY ACCLAMATION, EXCEPT WHEN THERE IS MORE THAN ONE NOMINEE FOR THE SAME OFFICE, and THEN THE ELECTION SHALL BE BY MAJORITY VOTE.

ARTICLE V — OFFICERS

SECTION 1. THE ELECTED OFFICERS OF THE CORPORATION SHALL CONSIST OF A PRESIDENT, VICE—PRESIDENT, SECRETARY AND TREASURER.

SECTION 2. THE PRESIDENT SHALL PRESIDE AT ALL MEETINGS OF THE CORPORATION AND OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS; APPOINT ALL CHAIRMAN NOT OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR, AND SHALL BE EX—OFFICIO MEMBER OF ALL COMMITTEES, EXCEPT THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE.

SECTION 3. THE VICE—PRESIDENT SHALL PERFORM ALL DUTIES OF THE PRESIDENT WHEN THE PRESIDENT IS ABSENT OR OTHERWISE UNABLE TO ACT; ALSO TO SERVE AS WAYS AND MEANS CHAIRMAN WHEN THAT POSITION IS UNFILLED.

SECTION 4. THE SECRETARY SHALL KEEP A PERMANENT RECORD AS REQUIRED AND TO PROVIDE CORRESPONDENCE AS NECESSARY; ALSO TO KEEP A ROSTER OF ALL MEMBERS OF THE CORPORATION.

SECTION 5. THE TREASURER SHALL HAVE CUSTODY OF ALL FUNDS AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL BOOKKEEPING AND ACCOUNTING; DEPOSIT THE FUNDS IN A BANK DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS; PAY BILLS WHICH ARE AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS; MAINTAIN AND SEE THAT FULL AND ACCURATE ACCOUNTS ARE KEPT, BE PREPARED TO MAKE A FINANCIAL REPORT AT MEETINGS,

AND FILE ALL REPORTS, FORMS AND OTHER INSTRUMENTS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

SECTION 6. IN THE EVENT OF A VACANCY OF ANY OF THE ABOVE, SAID OFFICER SHALL BE REPLACED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

ARTICLE VI — BOARDS

(A) THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL CONSIST OF SEVEN (7) VOTING MEMBERS: PRESIDENT, VICE-PRESIDENT, SECRETARY, TREASURER, IMMEDIATE PAST—PRESIDENT AND TWO (2) AT LARGE MEMBERS APPOINTED FROM THE MEMBERSHIP BY MAJORITY VOTE OF THE FIVE (5) CORE VOTING DIRECTORS. THREE (3) NON-VOTING MEMBERS: THE PRINCIPAL OF SALEM HIGH SCHOOL, THE BAND DIRECTOR AND THE CORPS COMMANDER.

(B) THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL, BY MAJORITY VOTE, BE EMPOWERED TO TRANSACT ANY BUSINESS BETWEEN MEETINGS OF THE SALEM BAND BOOSTER6, INC.

ARTICLE VII — MEETINGS

THERE SHALL BE AN ANNUAL MEETING IN AUGUST; ALL OTHER MEETINGS TO BE CALLED AT THE DIRECTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OR BY THE PRESIDENT.

ARTICLE VIII - COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN

SECTION 1.

(A) THE PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT THE FOLLOWING COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE ANNUAL MEETING; WAYS AND MEANS AND NOMINATIONS.

(B) THE PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT ALL OTHER CHAIRMEN NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT APPROVED PROJECTS.

SECTION 2. DUTIES OF THE APPOINTED COMMITTEE CHAIRMEN:

(A) WAYS AND MEANS CHAIRMAN SHALL DEVELOP METHODS OF FUND RAISING, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. HE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE EXECUTION OF APPROVED FUND RAISING PROJECTS.

(B) NOMINATIONS CHAIRMAN SHALL HEAD A COMMITTEE CONSISTING OF THREE MEMBERS, CHOSEN BY HIM IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING HIS APPOINTMENT AS CHAIRMAN. THIS COMMITTEE SHALL PRESENT A SLATE PRIOR TO THE SUBSEQUENT ANNUAL MEETING CONSISTING OF ONE OR MORE CANDIDATES FOR THE FOLLOWING OFFICES: PRESIDENT, VICE-PRESIDENT, SECRETARY AND TREASURER. NO NAME SHALL BE OFFERED UNLESS THE NOMINEE HAS CONSENTED TO SERVE IF ELECTED.

ARTICLE IX — DISSOLUTION

DISSOLUTION MUST FOLLOW RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE VIRGINIA NONSTOCK CORPORATION ACT AND ALL REMAINING ASSETS SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO AN ORGANIZATION OF RELATED OBJECTIVES.

ARTICLE X — PARLIMENTARY AUTHORITY

THE RULES CONTAINED IN ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER NEWLY REVISED SHALL GOVERN THE SALEM BAND BOOSTERS, INC. IN ALL CASES TO WHICH THEY ARE APPLICABLE AND IN WHICH THEY ARE NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE BYLAWS.

ARTICLE VI -BOARDS

ARTICLE XI — AMENDMENTS

THESE BYLAWS MAY BE AMENDED AT ANY MEETING OF THE SALEM BAND BOOSTERS, INC. BY A TWO—THIRDS VOTE OF THOSE PRESENT AND VOTING, PROVIDING NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT HAS BEEN GIVEN AT THE PREVIOUS MEETING AND IS NOT CONTRARY TO LAW.
